- Before finalizing the payment, carefully review the details you've entered.
- Follow the prompts to complete the payment process.
- Once the payment is successfully processed, you will receive a confirmation receipt. Keep this receipt as proof of your payment.

NOTE: *It's crucial to enter accurate details and verify the amount you need to pay. Payment to the wrong MDA is non-refundable, so exercise caution*
